# **Volunteer role description**

Title:	Live at Home volunteer car driver
Supported by:	You will have a named contact, usually the Manager of the Scheme
Main purpose:	To provide transport to benefit the older members of a Live at Home scheme

## 1 Overview of the role

As a Volunteer Driver you will provide transport to support to the older member of the Live at Home Scheme.

It is particularly important at this time of restricted movements, and shielding people who are vulnerable from transmission of illness by contact, to support them with shopping the groceries they need.

## 2 **Responsibilities**

- To provide a shopping service to one or more Live at Home Scheme member
- To receive a list of grocery items, and shop for the member from the list, selecting the most appropriate alternatives where availability is limited. The shopping activity will usually be limited to one location
- To collect pre-packaged shopping orders
- To shop for other essentials, as agreed. This may include pre-paid utility meter top-ups
- To deliver grocery items to the member's doorstep, maintaining appropriate distance to avoid putting the member at risk
- Report any concerns to the person who supports you e.g. if the older person does not answer the door, or you are concerned about their wellbeing
- To provide transport for other agreed activities which support Live at Home scheme members
- To be familiar with and to adhere MHA's Health and Safety Policies and policies relating to your volunteering role
- Inform your named contact at the earliest opportunity of any change in circumstances which affect your ability to continue with volunteering, such as holidays or periods of time you cannot volunteer

## 3 Skills and qualities needed for this role

- Good communication skills
- A clean driving licence
- An understanding of the needs of older people
- You will be reliable and punctual

- Flexibility
- You will have a strong driving safety awareness
- You will enjoy working with older people

## 4 What training and support will be provided

- We will provide you with a full induction for the role
- Training on safeguarding, health and safety and other training and updating of skills and knowledge relevant to the role as appropriate
- Ongoing support from a named contact
- Out of pocket expenses in accordance with MHA's Expenses Policy
